| Exceptional costs | Percentage of actual costs | 100% of eligible costs | Conditional: the request for financial support to cover exceptional costs must be motivated in the application form | Full justification of the costs actually incurred and duly completed financial statements. |

IMPORTANT! Unit cost $A_{4.3c}$ changes according to the country. The applicant must apply the scale of unit costs of the country hosting the activity. The amounts applicable per country can be found in the table below.

Which costs can be covered under the category "Exceptional costs"?

Exceptional costs eligible for grant are considered:

- visa and visa-related costs as well as vaccination costs;
- costs related to participants with special needs.

In the latter cases, the grant may cover, for example, medical visits; health care; additional linguistic training/support; additional preparation; special premises or equipment; additional accompanying person; additional personal expenses in the case of economic disadvantage; translation/interpretation.
